CONSTRUCTION



The Girls' Dormitory was officially opened at Empakasi Secondary School in February 2018, where 60 girls mainly Masai can now stay there during term time. This ensures daily class attendance and not walking many kilometers to school or hitching rides from unscrupulous lorry drivers who go to this area for sand collection. We also constructed a girls' and boys' dormitory at Mathatani Secondary School which will have its first intake of

A ground breaking ceremony for the construction of a boys' dormitory at Katani Secondary School took place on 27th October 2018 which is proudly funded by our pro bono auditors, Grant Thornton. Also noteworthy is that 44 staff and well-wishers of GT climbed Mt Kenya to raise funds for this project that is due to be completed by March 2019. A library structure was built for Ngwata Primary School due to the ballooned student population and also constructed kitchens at;

FEEDING PROGRAMME & VEGETABLE GARDENS

Schools are encouraged to have their own vegetable gardens so that they can grow a variety of vegetables to add to their meals.



New school uniforms were distributed to 5 schools namely: Kanaani Primary School- 729 uniforms Mt View Primary School- 156 uniforms Kwa Kalusya Primary School- 124 uniforms Kwa Mboo Primary School- 200 uniforms Ngalalya Primary School- 355 uniforms

Sanitary towels were distributed to girls at Mathatani Secondary School, Kanaani Primary School and Kanaani Secondary School.

Most of our Amara primary school students have gone to secondary schools and some secondary school students have even been accepted into various universities.

WORKSHOPS

Introduced karate to Kanaani Secondary School which has now become an all girls school. Karate classes at Kanaani Primary School is now in its 4th year and several students have entered various competitions country wide. Thirteen Karateka's were graded on 16th February 2018. The grading was conducted by Kenya Goju Ryu Association technical bench. They all attained yellow belt.

Workshops were initiated at Kyangoma Special Needs School. In 2019, 4 students from this school will join another institution/NGO where they will be educated on hygiene, grooming and trained in carpentry, welding, cooking and hairdressing which will empower and enable them to earn a living.

Amara had organized an inter- schools competition and Kanaani Primary School took the prize for best school and best students.
