Kwa Kalusya Success Story - Lukenya

- The number of students has increased and their grades have improved tremendously.
- The school's shamba is thriving with vegetables and fruit trees, and the school is able to sustain itself with a variety of food.
- Kwa Kalusya Secondary school has been started and they are using the primary facilities at the moment.

2) Kyangoma Special Needs School- Kikima

- The Girls dormitory with 38 beds was completed in September 2013
- Amara has agreed to pay for 2 vocational training teachers who will teach various skills such as tailoring, carpentry. This is to ensure that children who leave school will have some income generating skills.

 32 children are participating in it and the classes are conducted once a week.
- Text books and other stationery have been donated to the school.
- Peer to Peer interactions are ongoing with the Aga khan Academy.
- Desks and national curriculum books have been donated.
- Kanaani have been lucky to be identified as a recipient for a borehole.
